

Noise Variance for City of Onalaska Golf Courses

Attached find a draft of the public hearing notice for the November 5, 2014 Administrative Committee meeting. Also attached is a draft ordinance to be presented to the committee. The notice will be printed in the Onalaska-Holmen Courier ?? times and posted on the city website. The committee had discussed also mailing out the notice to the 250 foot list for each golf course. Below is the breakdown of residents and the cost for each:

Cedar Creek	112 residents	\$54.88
La Crosse Country Club	159 residents	\$77.91
Coulee Golf Bowl	80 residents	\$39.20
Totals residents/ postage for mailings	351 residents	\$171.99

This does not include the cost for paper, envelopes and staff time nor the cost of the publication for the public hearing. This is not a budgeted item, so the cost will be coming out of the council budget if we proceed with this.

ORDINANCE NO. ____ - 2014

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 11 CHAPTER 2 OF THE CITY OF ONALASKA CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO NOISE VIOLATIONS

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ONALASKA DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Subsection (c)(4) of Section 9 of Chapter 2 of Title 11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Onalaska is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

(4ll) **Operation of Certain Equipment.** Lawnmowers, chainsaws, powered garden equipment, electric insect killing/repelling devices, and other non-construction maintenance equipment shall be operated only during the hours between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. unless within the specified noise levels measured at the property line of the location at which said equipment is in use. Golf Courses in the City of Onalaska may operate maintenance equipment for golf course maintenance between the hours of 5:30 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.


