30" x 60" frame tent with 7' sidewalls secured by Concrete weights as specified by Tent Company. South east corner of the tent will be placed no closer than 15' to the south east corner of the painted parking stall. Entrance and main exit will be on the 30' end facing Hwy 16 (South).






Site Layout

No chemical composition is released or exposed during normal handling, storage, and transportation. In the event of a vehicle fire or if intense heat reaches the cargo area, the fireworks are likely to ignite. They will burn, spreading burning particles over a limited area. A mass explosion is not expected. Smoke and potentially irritating gases will be produced in a fire. If the fireworks are spilled as the result of an accident but do not ignite, they can safely be picked up and repackaged. The area should be kept cleared of unnecessary people while this is being done.

EMERGENCY ACTION

In case of fire, stop traffic, isolate the immediate area, and deny entry. Keep unnecessary people away.

Fires in cargo area can be fought with water spray if necessary, although disposal and site clean up will be simplified if material is allowed to burn. Try to prevent other types of fire from reaching the cargo area.

FIRE

Truck fire (other than cargo area): Flood with water. Tire fires may start again. Unhook and separate tractor from trailer, if possible. Remove vehicle that is not involved in fire from fire area if you can do so without risk. If cargo area is exposed to heat and flames, direct water spray on outside of container to cool it down. Continue spray until well after fire is out.

Cargo fire: Do not move cargo or vehicle if cargo has been exposed to heat.

Shut off all ignition sources. There shall be no flares, smoking, tools capable of producing sparks, or flames in the vicinity of the spilled material.

Cautiously pick up the spilled devices and place them in cardboard cartons.

FIRST AID

Call emergency medical care.

Use first aid treatment according to the nature of the injury.







However, our Law Enforcement Committee is reviewing a change to that ordinance and it will probably be scheduled for a public hearing next month. The new ordinance does not allow chickens at all UNLESS it is an area zoned Agriculture.

I received a call today from a realtor representing a family wanting to move out of the City of La Crosse, but they want to bring the chickens with them. I warned her this will not be allowed any longer. She started to berate me on how West Salem could have so many more residents if we were to allow chickens. Whatever... I know the particular neighborhood she was inquiring about, and I know the neighbors there would be on the phone immediately to me to complain about it! The advantages of a small town—we know everybody and what they will and will not like.

(GG) KEEPING OF CHICKENS.

Residents may own, keep or harbor up to five (5) chickens subject to the provisions of this Code.

(1) License Requirement.

- (a) Any person who owns, keeps or harbors chickens in the City of La Crosse shall obtain an annual license prior to January 1 of each year, or within thirty (30) days of acquiring the chickens. The term year of a license commences on January 1 and ends the following December 31. Residents deciding to own, keep or harbor chickens for successive years must obtain a new license for each term year they own, keep or harbor such chickens.
- (b) In the event a complaint has been filed with the City prior to renewal of said license within the calendar year prior to renewal, applicants must receive written approval from not less than fifty percent (50%) of the owner-occupied neighboring property owners whose property is within 100 feet of the applicant's property lines exclusive of street right of way prior to approval of said license by the Common Council. If no complaint has been received, the license application shall be sent to the Judiciary and Administrative Committee only for consideration. (Ord. 4746 - 4/11/13)
- (c) Applications shall be made to the City Treasurer and the fee for the license shall be in accordance with Section 25.01 of this Code. (Ord. #4651 - 1/12/12)
- (d) The Treasurer or other authorized individual shall collect the fee and shall assess and collect a late fee in accordance with Section 25.01 of this Code from every owner of chickens, if the owner fails to obtain a license prior to April 1 of each year, or fails to obtain a license within thirty (30) days of acquiring the chickens. All late fees received or collected shall be paid into the local Treasury. (Ord. #4651 - 1/12/12)
- (e) No person shall own, keep or harbor any chickens, or build, erect or maintain and use any chicken coop, house, yard or other building or structure to keep or harbor chickens anywhere within the City without obtaining a license as required by this section.
- (f) The City of La Crosse and its officers may revoke a license if there are three (3) or more violations within any consecutive twelve (12) month period of this or any other section of this Code.
- (g) All applicants must notify the owner or operator of the property if the applicant is not the owner or operator. Notification is not required for renewal of a permit.

(2) Use Conditions.

- (a) Any owner, occupier, or user of property within the City of La Crosse who chooses to own, keep or harbor chickens and any chicken coop permitted under this section shall be limited to following conditions:

- (i) One (1) property is limited to the keeping or harboring of up to five (5) chickens.
- (ii) A person may only own, keep or harbor chickens on property being used as a Single Family Residential Dwelling.
- (iii) No person shall keep any rooster.
- (iv) No person shall slaughter any chickens.
- (v) The chickens shall be provided with a covered enclosure and must be kept in the covered enclosure or a fenced enclosure within the backyard of the property at all times.
- (vi) No enclosure shall be located closer than twenty five (25) feet to any residential structure on an adjacent lot.

(3) Public Health and Safety Concerns.

- (a) No person shall keep any chicken or other fowl within the City of La Crosse in any unsanitary condition or within such proximity of dwelling houses or in any manner so as to be a nuisance.
- (b) All chicken coops, yards and other buildings shall be kept in a clean, sanitary condition and free from all objectionable odors and shall be subject to the inspection and approval of the City of La Crosse and the La Crosse County Public Health Department or their agents.
- (c) The La Crosse County Public Health Department, City of La Crosse and their agents shall have jurisdiction to inspect the premises upon which chickens are kept and ascertain and determine whether the conditions are unsanitary or if for any reason a nuisance is caused thereby.
- (d) A complaint against any person owning, keeping or harboring chickens in accordance with this section may be filed with the City of the La Crosse County Department of Public Health. If filed with the City, the City shall then be required to forward the complaint to the La Crosse County Department of Public Health. If the La Crosse County Public Health Department, the City of La Crosse or their agents determines that conditions are unsanitary, or if for any reason a nuisance exists, they shall have authority to order the owner or occupant of the premises to abate the nuisance and it shall thereupon be unlawful to keep such chickens on the premises.
- (e) If an investigation from the City reveals that the use of chickens is in violation of this section or any other section of this Code the City shall have authority to require the owner or user of the property to fix, abate, or alleviate the problem. If the problem is not satisfactorily abated or alleviated the City of La Crosse shall have authority to revoke the license.

- (4) Bird Noise. In accordance with this section, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, or other entity operating, having charge of, or occupying any building to own, keep, harbor or allow to be kept any chicken which shall habitually by any noise disturb the peace and quiet of any person in the vicinity thereof.

- (5) Rat Harborage to be Prevented. All chicken yards, coops, pens or houses shall be constructed or repaired as to prevent rats from being harbored underneath the same or within the walls thereof, and all food products or other products, goods or wares likely to attract or to become infested with or infected by rats shall be protected as to prevent rats from gaining access thereto or coming in contact therewith.



ORDINANCE NO. 6.08 (N)-2014**An Ordinance to Amend Section 6.08 (N) of the Town of Campbell Code of Ordinances Relating to Species Allowed and Prohibited Within the Town****6.08 (N)**

(I) SPECIES ALLOWED WITHIN THE TOWN: Residents may keep up to two (2) dogs, three (3) cats, and five (5) chickens.

(A) License Requirement

- (a) Any person who owns, keeps or harbors chickens in the Town of Campbell shall obtain a license within thirty (30) days of acquiring the chickens. The term year of a license commences on January 1 and ends the following December 31. The renewal period for said license shall be from January 1 through April 1 of each year. There shall be a late fee of \$25 if the owner fails to obtain a license prior to April 1 of each year.
- (b) In the event a complaint has been filed with the Town, applicants must receive written approval from not less than fifty percent (50%) of the neighboring property owners whose property is within 100 feet of the applicant's property lines prior to approval of said license by the Town Board.
- (c) Applications shall be made to the Town Clerk and the fee shall be in accordance with Section 1.13 of the Town of Campbell Code of Ordinances.
- (d) No person shall own, keep or harbor chickens, or build, erect or maintain and use any chicken coop, house, yard or other building structure to keep or harbor chickens anywhere within the Town without obtaining a license as required by this section.
- (e) The Town of Campbell shall revoke a license if there are three (3) or more violations of this section.

(B) Use Conditions

- (a) Any owner, occupier, or user of property within the Town of Campbell who chooses to own, keep or harbor chickens and any chicken coop permitted under this section shall be limited to the following conditions:
 - (i) One (1) property is limited to the keeping or harboring of up to five (5) chickens.
 - (ii) A person may only own, keep or harbor chickens on property being used as a Single Family Residential Dwelling.
 - (iii) No person shall keep any rooster.
 - (iv) No person shall slaughter any chickens.

- (v) The chickens shall be provided with a covered enclosure and must be kept in the covered enclosure or a fenced enclosure within the backyard of the property at all times.
- (vi) No enclosure shall be located closer than twenty five (25) feet to any residential structure on an adjacent lot.
- (vii) All enclosures shall be constructed as to prevent rats from being harbored underneath the same or within the walls. All food products that may attract rats are to be protected as to prevent rats from gaining access.

(C) Public Health and Safety Concerns

- (a) No person shall keep any chicken within the Town of Campbell in any unsanitary condition or within such proximity of dwelling houses or in any manner so as to be a nuisance.
- (b) All chicken coops, yards and other buildings shall be kept in a clean, sanitary condition and free from all objectionable odors and shall be subject to the inspection and approval of the Town of Campbell and the La Crosse County Public Health Department or their agents.
- (c) The La Crosse County Health Department, Town of Campbell and their agents shall have jurisdiction to inspect the premises upon which chickens are kept and ascertain and determine whether the conditions are unsanitary or if for any reason a nuisance is caused thereby.
- (d) A complaint against any person owning, keeping or harboring chickens in accordance with this section may be filed with the Town of Campbell or the La Crosse County Department of Health. If filed with the Town, the Town shall then be required to forward the complaint to the La Crosse County Department of Public Health. If the conditions are deemed unsanitary, or if for any reason a nuisance exists, they shall have the authority to order the owner or occupant of the premises to abate the nuisance and it shall thereupon be unlawful to keep such chickens on the premises.
- (e) If the Town finds the use of chickens is in violation of this section or any other section of this Code the Town shall have the authority to require the owner or user of the property to fix, abate, or alleviate the problem. If the problem is not satisfactorily abated or alleviated the Town of Campbell shall have the authority to revoke the license.

(D) Bird Noise

In accordance with this section, it shall be unlawful for any person, occupying any building to own, keep, harbor or to allow to be kept any chicken which shall habitually by any noise disturb the peace and quiet of any person in the vicinity thereof.

(2) SPECIES PROHIBITED WITHIN THE TOWN: The species named in this section are by their nature or actions considered to be a public nuisance and hereby declared to be a nuisance within the Town and may not be kept by any person within Town limits. Species prohibited by this section include: livestock, including all cattle, horses, mules and donkeys, sheep and goats and swine, and also all mink, foxes, skunks, raccoons, geese, ducks, bees, poisonous snakes, alligators, and crocodiles.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon posting of the Ordinance as required by Sec. 60.80 of the Wisconsin State Statutes.







ORDINANCE NO. 1472 - 2014

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 3 CHAPTER 4 OF THE CITY OF ONALASKA CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO DISPOSAL OF UNCLAIMED FUNDS

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ONALASKA DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Section 3 of Chapter 4 of Title 3 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of

Onalaska is hereby created to read:

Sec. 3-4-3 Unclaimed Funds

- (a) **Unclaimed Funds.** On or before January 10 of every odd-numbered year, the City of Onalaska Finance Director or its designee, shall file with the treasurer of La Crosse County a written report under oath giving the names and the last-known addresses of all persons for whom the City of Onalaska Treasurer holds money or security, and which has not been claimed for at least one year, and showing the amount of the money or the nature of the security in detail. A duplicate report shall also be mailed to the Wisconsin Department of Financial Institutions. Upon receiving the reports the La Crosse County Treasurer shall cause to be published a class 3 notice, under ch. 985 of the Wisconsin Statutes, on or before February 1 of the same year, which contains the names and last-known addresses of the owners of the unclaimed money or security that has a value of at least \$10, and shall state that unless the owners call for and prove their ownership of the money or security, within 6 months from the time of the completed publication, the City of Onalaska Treasurer shall give possession or control of the money or security to the La Crosse County Treasurer. At the end of the 6 months from the time of the completed publication, the La Crosse County Treasurer shall also take possession or control of all money or security of persons for whom the City of Onalaska Treasurer holds money or security, and which has not been claimed for at least one year, if the money or security has a value of less than \$10.
- (b) **Unclaimed Funds in County Possession.** Any money or security which the La Crosse County Treasurer has taken control over under Section (a) above and has had in its possession or control for more than one year shall, to the extent possible, be deposited into the La Crosse County general revenue fund. Pursuant to Wisconsin Statute §59.66(2)(a)1(am) money or security deposited pursuant to this section may remain in the County's general revenue fund or may be used by La Crosse County until the money or security is paid or delivered to its owner or becomes property of the county. If within 10 years from the time any such money or security is delivery to La Crosse County, the owner of the money or security proves to the satisfaction of the La Crosse County Treasurer the owner's right to the possession of the money or security, it shall be paid or delivered to the owner. If no such proof is made, then at the end of the 10-year period the money or property shall become the property of the county. Nothing in these sections shall be construed to deprive the owner of any such property of the owner's right to proceed by court action for the recovery of such money or security from the treasurer.
- (c) **Penalty.** Any person violating any provision of this section, shall upon conviction be fined not less than \$50 nor more than \$200 or imposed for not less than 30 days nor more than 6 months.

ORDINANCE NO. 1473 - 2014

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 11 CHAPTER 2 OF THE CITY OF
ONALASKA CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO FIREARMS**

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ONALASKA DOES HEREBY

ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Section 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 11 of the Code of Ordinances of the
City of Onalaska is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

Sec. 11-2-1 Regulation of Firearms and Explosives.

- (a) **Discharge of Firearms and Guns Regulated.** No person shall fire or discharge any cannon, gun, pistol, air or spring gun or any firearm of any description within the City of Onalaska without having first obtained written permission from the Chief of Police, which permission shall limit the time and fix the place of such shooting and shall be subject to be revoked at any time after the same may have been granted, except this section shall not be construed to prohibit the discharge of firearms by the Sheriff or any of his deputies, the Chief of Police or any of his subordinates or any public officer when required and made necessary in the performance of any duty imposed by law.
- (b) **Shooting Into City Limits.** No person shall in the territory adjacent to the City discharge any firearm in such manner that the discharge shall enter or fall within the City.
- (c) **Shooting Ranges.** This section shall not prevent the maintenance and use of duly supervised rifle or pistol ranges or shooting galleries approved by the Common Council, after an advisory recommendation from the Chief of Police, where proper safety precautions are taken.
- (d) **Explosive Devices.** No person shall discharge or detonate any dynamite, nitroglycerin or other explosive within the City without first obtaining a permit to do so from the Chief of Police.
- (e) **Hunting Prohibited.** Hunting with a firearm is prohibited within the corporate limits of the City of Onalaska.
- (f) **Definitions.** For purposes of this Section, a firearm is defined as any instrumentality from or with which a shot, bullet or pellet may be discharged or expelled, regardless of whether the propelling force is provided by air, spring or other similar mechanical device, or gun powder.
- (g) **Penalty.** Any person who violates this section shall upon conviction be subject to a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00 per offense.

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and prior to publication although it will be published in due course.



ORDINANCE NO. 1474 - 2014

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 11 CHAPTER 2 OF THE CITY OF ONALASKA
CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO HUNTING WITH BOW AND ARROWS,
CROSS BOW**

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ONALASKA DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Section 4 of Chapter 2 of Title 11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
Onalaska is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

**Sec. 11-2-4 Hunting with and Throwing or Shooting of, Arrows, Stones and Other
Missiles.**

- (a) **Throwing or Shooting of Arrows, Stones and Other Missiles.** It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge or throw by any means any dangerous missile, object, arrow, stone, snowball or other missile within the City of Onalaska for any purpose other than the hunting of wild animals as defined in section (b) below, provided, however, upon written application to the Chief of Police and Common Council, a person may be granted permission by the Common Council to construct and maintain supervised non-commercial archery ranges if, in the opinion of the Common Council, the construction or maintenance of such ranges will not endanger the public health and safety.
- (b) **Hunting Wild Animals with Bow & Arrows and Cross Bows.** To preserve the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Onalaska, the use of bow and arrow or cross bow for the purposes of hunting of wild animals under this Section shall not be permitted in City parks or parkways, on school property and City or Federal Property, except as set forth in the City's Urban Deer Management Plan. For the purposes of this ordinance, wild animal shall have the definition assigned in Wis. Stat. §29.001(90).
 - a. Anyone engaged in hunting wild animals in the City of Onalaska must receive prior permission from the landowner.
 - b. Persons hunting with a bow and arrow or crossbow must discharge the arrow or bolt from the respective weapon into the ground.
 - c. Hunting wild animals with a bow and arrow or crossbow is prohibited within One Hundred (100) yards of any building. This restriction shall not apply if the person who owns the land on which the building is located allows the hunter to hunt within the specified distance of the building. For purposes of this Section, "building" means permanent structure used for human occupancy and includes a manufactured home as defined in Wisconsin Statute Section 101.91(2)(d).
- (c) **Penalty.** Any person who violates section (a) or (b), shall upon conviction be subject to a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00 per offense.

SECTION I. Section 17 of Chapter 2 of Title 11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Onalaska is hereby deleted and replaced with:

Sec. 11-2-17 Prohibition of Smoking in Enclosed and Specified Places

- (a) The provisions of Section 101.123 of the Wisconsin Statutes as amended by 2009 Wisconsin Act 12 relating to the prohibition of smoking in various enclosed spaces are hereby adopted and made part of this Code by reference, including any revisions or amendments thereto. Pursuant to Wisconsin Statute, a warning notice shall be issued to the Person in Charge as defined in Wisconsin Stat. Sec. 101.123(1)(d) for the first offense.
- (b) **Penalty.** Any person violating any provision of this section, including those provisions of the Wisconsin Statutes, which are incorporated herein by reference, shall upon conviction thereof forfeit not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$250.00 and the costs of prosecution for each violation, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and the costs of prosecution shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution, but not exceeding ninety (90) days for violation, provided, however, that in no case shall the forfeiture imposed for a violation of any provisions of this section exceed the maximum fine for the same offense under the laws of the State of Wisconsin.)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 11 CHAPTER 5 SECTION 9 OF THE CITY OF ONALASKA CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO PURCHASE OR POSSESSION OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ONALASKA DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Section 9 of Chapter 5 of Title 11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Onalaska is hereby deleted and replaced with:

Sec. 11-5-9 Purchase or Possession of Tobacco Products and Nicotine Products

(a) Definition of Tobacco Products.

- (1) For the purposes of this Section, "tobacco products" means any tobacco related device and any substance containing tobacco leaf, including, but not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco, snuff, chewing tobacco or dipping tobacco and shall include nicotine product defined as any electronic smoking device that can be used to delivery nicotine or any other substances to the person inhaling from the device. The term "nicotine product" shall include a product that contains nicotine including, but not limited to, such devices whether they are manufactured as electronic cigarettes, electronic cigars, electronic pipes or any other product name.
- (b) **Purchase by Minors Prohibited.** It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen (18) years to purchase tobacco products, or to misrepresent their identity or age, or to use any false or altered identification for the purpose of purchasing tobacco products or nicotine products.
- (c) **Possession by Minors Prohibited.** It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen (18) years to possess any tobacco products; provided that the possession by a person under the age of eighteen (18) years under the direct supervision of the parent or legal guardian of such person in the privacy of the parent's or legal guardian's home shall not be prohibited.
- (d) **Sale of Tobacco Products to Minors Prohibited.** No person may purchase cigarettes, tobacco products or nicotine product on behalf of or provide to any person who is under 18 years of age. A law enforcement officer shall seize any cigarettes, tobacco products or nicotine products.
- (d) **Statutes Adopted.** The provisions of Secs. 254.92, 134.66 and 778.25(1)(a), Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference and incorporated herein.
- (e) **Violations.** For purposes of determining previous violations, the thirty (30) month period shall be measured from the dates of violations that resulted in an imposition of a forfeiture or a conviction. For the purpose of determining whether or not a previous violation has occurred, if more than one (1) violation occurs at the same time, all those violations shall be counted as one (1) violation. A person who commits a violation of Subsections (b) or (c) above shall be liable to a penalty of not more than

One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). A person who commits a violation of Subsection (d) above may be:

- (1) Required to forfeit not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) if the person has not committed a previous violation within thirty (30) months of the violation; or
- (2) Fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or imprisoned for not more than 30 days or both if the person has committed a previous violation within thirty (30) months of the violation.
- (3) Fined not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than 90 days or both if the person has committed two (2) previous violations within thirty (30) months of the violation.
- (4) Fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than 9 months or both if the person has committed three (3) or more previous violations within thirty (30) months of the violation.
- (5) In addition to the forfeitures provided in Subsections (e)(1)-(4) above, a court shall suspend any license issued under Chapter 3 of Title 7 of the City of Onalaska Code of Ordinances to a person violating this Subsection for:
 - a. Not more than three (3) days, if the court finds that the person committed a violation within twelve (12) months after committing one (1) previous violation;
 - b. Not less than three (3) days nor more than ten (10) days, if the court finds that the person committed a violation within twelve (12) months after committing two (2) other violations; or
 - c. Not less than fifteen (15) days nor more than thirty (30) days, if the court finds that the person committed the violation within twelve (12) months after committing three (3) other violations.




