## RECOMMENDED LOW GROWING BOULEVARD TREES CITY OF ONALASKA

The following low growing trees are recommended for use on boulevards with power lines:

1. ***Autumn Blaze Callery Pear*** – estimated 25’ tall x 25’ wide; pH adaptable and is urban and salt tolerant
2. ***Amur Chokecherry***- estimated 20’- 25’ tall x 15’ – 18’ wide; blooms white with black fruit
3. ***Purple Leaf Sand Cherry Tree*** – estimated 8’ tall x 6’-8’ wide, with purple foliage all season; tough and drought tolerant.
4. ***Gray Dogwood*** (tree form) – estimated 10’-15’ tall x 10’-12’ wide; tough and not very fast growing.
5. ***Crabapple*** (various varieties): all crabapples have good disease resistance.

***Profusion*** – estimated 15’ tall x 15’ wide; blooms pink

***Adams*** – estimated 20’ tall x 20’ wide; blooms pink

***Red Splendor*** – estimated 20’ tall x 20’ wide; blooms pink

***Firebird*** – estimated 5’ tall x 8’ wide (5’ tall now and will fill out over time); blooms white.

***Lancelot*** – estimated 10’ tall x 8’ wide; blooms white.

***Corral Burst*** – estimated 10’ tall x 12’-15’ wide; blooms white.

6. ***Globe Locust*** – estimated 12’ tall x 12’ wide; fairly tough; has an umbrella shape.
7. ***Crimson Cloud Hawthorn*** – estimated 15’ tall x 10’-15’ wide; flowers red in spring; has some potential disease problems.
8. ***Redbud*** – estimated 20-30’ tall and 25-30’ wide.
9. ***Lilac*** (tree form) – estimate 20-25’ tall and 15-20’ wide.
