4th Annual "Cops Gone Wild"

Police Officers from around the Coulee Region are planning to "Go Wild" at the 4th annual "Cops Gone Wild" Special Olympics fundraiser on February 19th at the Onalaska Buffalo Wild Wings. From noon until 8 p.m. Officers will be at Buffalo Wild Wings to greet diners and help out the wait staff to raise money for Special Olympics.

"This will be the fourth year that our department has partnered with Buffalo Wild Wings for this fund raiser," said Onalaska Investigator Peter Jakowski, "we're hoping for another successful event, all the proceeds go to benefit the Special Olympic Athletes.
