THREE ARRESTED ON DRUG CHARGES AFTER HOUSE FIRE

Onalaska Fire Fighters were summoned to a house fire at 513 Green Street in Onalaska on September 12th. The fire was successfully extinguished but in the course of securing the residence Fire Fighters spotted what appeared to be drug paraphernalia and mushrooms in the basement. Onalaska Police Officers were summoned and in the course of an interview the home owner, Scott Stalsberg, he admitted that there were illegal mushrooms in the residence. A search warrant was then obtained. During the search the officers discovered various drug paraphernalia, mushrooms (Psilocybin), marijuana and the prescription drug Hydrocodone. The officers then arrested the home owner, Scott Stalsberg (24) of Onalaska and his tenant Justin Dahlberg (23) also of Onalaska. Stalsberg was charged with possession of prescription drugs without a prescription, possession of psilocybin (mushrooms) and maintaining a drug house. Dahlberg was charged with maintaining a drug traffic house and possession of psilocybin. David Cummutha of Madison who was staying in the residence was released on signature bond for possession of Marijuana. Stalsberg and Dahlberg remain in jail.
